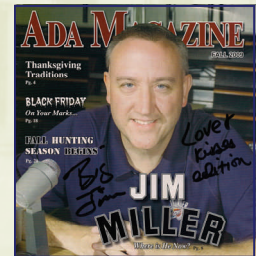
ARP loves to do shows such as this as it gives the group
